IASJF Ninth International Symposium on the Jurisprudence of the Family

The International Academy for the Study of the Jurisprudence of the Family (“IASJF”) is pleased to announce that it will hold its 9th international symposium on the jurisprudence of the family on the topic of “Family and Human Rights.”

It would be held on Wednesday and Thursday, June 15-16, 2016, at San Pablo Catholic University Faculty of Law, located in Arequipa, Perú. *It would be followed with an organized tour to the City of Arequipa* (which has been declared "World Heritage), *which would take place on Friday, June 17th.*

The Symposium will address the issues related to the topic from a juridical point of view; interdisciplinary presentations are also welcome.

The International Academy (IASJF), is an independent, interdisciplinary scholarly society that seeks to promote thoughtful consideration and discussion of the foundations of the family, including marriage, parenting, extended and other family relations. The IASJF has previously hosted academic symposia at Boston College Law School in Boston, Massachusetts, USA; at Bratislava Law School of Pan-European University in Bratislava, Slovakia; at Pontifical Catholic University of Buenos Aires in Buenos Aires, Argentina; at the University of Malta in Valletta, Malta; hosted by the Doha International Institute for Family Studies and Development in Doha, Qatar; at Cardozo Law School, New York city, USA; at University of La Coruña, Spain; and at Ono College, Kiryat Ono, Israel. The IASJF sponsors the International Journal of the Jurisprudence of the Family (“IJJF”), published in both print editions and in HeinOnline. Papers from prior symposia have been published in past volumes of the IJF; and selected submitted papers from the 2016 Symposium will be published in volume 7 of the IJF.

Persons wishing to present a scholarly paper at the symposium should submit a short abstract of the paper they propose (no more than one page) including a working title, the identity, institutional affiliation and full contact information of the author(s), and a brief description of the paper proposed. Proposals should be sent to Professor Lynn D. Acceptances will be on a rolling-acceptance basis. All symposium participants must register (\$ 85 Academy Members, \$ 130 non-Members, when registered by 30 April 2016; after this date, 25 \$ will be added to the regular fees: \$ 110 for Academy Members, \$ 155 for non-Members) and pay for their own transportation and hotel.
